Health & Safety Policy

Our objective is to provide and maintain safe and healthy working conditions, equipment and systems of work for everyone who attends our classes.

We will ensure that:

- Classes are of a size appropriate to the levels and techniques being taught and the space being used.
- Students in each class will be of compatible age/and or standard.
- We are aware of developments in Child Protection legislation.
- All adults who run or assist in the running of classes are CRB checked.
- Teaching facilities are adequately maintained and will provide:
 1. Suitable flooring appropriate to the technique being taught, with a clean, safe surface; to minimise the risk of injury.
 2. Adequate heating levels and ventilation.
 3. Suitable areas for changing and clear guidance as to the supervision of children whilst using the Heights facilities.
- All accidents are recorded and reported to the parent or carer.
- The premises contain an appropriately stocked first-aid box.
- The premises display the required fire regulations and that these are communicated to parents and carers.
- All teachers are fully qualified and competent to teach their subjects
- Public Liability insurance certificates are available on request.
- This policy is regularly reviewed and updated as necessary.

Parents / carers are responsible for

- Letting the teacher know if their child has any injury or upset that may affect performance in class.
- Letting the teacher know if they become aware of any issues relating to health and safety.
